Whether it's shortening a roller coaster line, streamlining an operating room, distributing products worldwide, or manufacturing superior automobiles, all share the common goal of saving companies money and increasing efficiencies."

Industrial engineers work in many different types of organizations. They apply their special skills in hospitals, banks, manufacturing plants, insurance companies, or government agencies. Major employers of industrial engineers include corporations such as Microsoft, Boeing, Disney, Intel, and Nike. And the list goes on.

You may find ways to make sure employees always have what they need to complete their job. You may survey locations to find the best place to build a major facility.
